The Port of New York and New Jersey

The Port of New York and New Jersey is the largest port on the East Coast and the third largest in the U.S. We’re the gateway to one of the most concentrated consumer markets in the world. From our six terminals, four on-dock ExpressRail facilities, warehouses and distribution centers — shippers have direct access to consumers in the Northeast, Midwest, and Canada by truck or rail.

STRATEGIC LOCATION

Access to 28 million consumers in the local region and another 106 million more in New England and across the Midwest, and Eastern Canada which can be reached within 36 hours.

SUPERIOR NAVIGATION

With the completed harbor deepening (50’ MLW) and the elevation of the Bayonne Bridge (215’ MHW), our port continues to handle the world’s largest container ships.

SIX TERMINALS

As one of the most high-volume ports in the world, our container terminal operators:

- Handle more first calls than all other East Coast ports combined.
- Process about approximately 7.6 million TEUs per year, over \$200 billion worth of cargo.
- Serve 12 independent ocean carriers from around the globe, including all of the major global alliances as well as 12 independent carriers.

SPEED TO MARKET

Goods get into the hands of consumers quickly with the intermodal on-dock ExpressRail system serviced by two Class One railroad systems (CSX and Norfolk Southern), along with access to nearby air and road transportation.

SUPPLY CHAIN PARTNERS

Shippers have access to one of the largest concentrations of warehousing and distribution facilities in the country, with nearly one billion square feet of space within 50 miles.

SKILLED WORKFORCE

At the heart of our port’s high performance is a workforce skilled in today’s equipment and systems committed to efficiency and productivity.

The Council on Port Performance (CPP), comprised of shipping industry executives, provides leadership on ways to continuously improve operational efficiency and service reliability.






